

Princess Elisabeth von Rochlitz (1502-1557)

She was a Hessian princess and, by marriage, Hereditary Princess of Saxonv. She was instrumental. against the opposition of her father-in-law Duke George, in introducing the in Saxonv. and saw to the appointment of Protestant clergy in her territory.
